

## Understanding MAP® Growth<sup>™</sup> Scores In LinkIt

You will find your child's score on the MAP® Growth<sup>™</sup> assessment for Math in the parent portal. Students in Kindergarten through second grade took this assessment.

Your child's overall MAP Growth results are represented as a **RIT score**. RIT scores have the same meaning across grade levels. This stable scale allows teachers to accurately measure each student's academic growth throughout the school year and over time.

In LinkIt you will also see a percentile. This percentile indicates how students performed compared to their peers. For example, if your child's score was at the 30th percentile, this means they scored better than 30 percent of their peers.

In addition to the overall score, you will see how your child performed in the different areas that make up the overall score. This can provide information about relative strengths and weaknesses.

While this assessment can be a valuable instructional tool, it is just one measure of your child's ability. If you have questions about your child's performance or growth, please contact their teacher.
