

REACH Program

Description

• The Chesterfield Township Elementary School REACH program (formerly known as the Gifted & Talented Program) is a dynamic small group program that is both challenging and meaningful to our students. Students must meet a set of varied and stringent criteria to be eligible to participate in the additional work required. The goal of the program is to support a learning environment that encourages students to engage their abilities to the greatest extent possible.

Student Evaluations/Identification

- The REACH Program Matrix of multiple measures and is an ongoing process. Students are placed onto the matrix and evaluated due to one of the following reasons:
 - IQ/cognitive score
 - Parent/guardian nomination located on the CES website & due the third week of Sept.
 - Teacher recommendation
 - Was a member of the program the previous school year
