Camp Fire NJ provides SEL programs in classrooms during the school year. Programs run 6-10 weeks, run by instructors and facilitators from Camp Fire NJ. The programs I was hoping we can acquire are for grades 2, 4, and 6. These are evidence based, age appropriate programs. Every year the re-evaluate their curricula to perfect it and keep it current.

**Who:** 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers and students.

**What:** They would receive programs that address issues that are pertinent to those grade levels.

**Why:** students in 2<sup>nd</sup> will benefit from learning healthy habits and harmful behaviors, as self-esteem building, and how to distinguish between the two. 4<sup>th</sup> grade deals a lot with cliques and finding out who they are as well as which group they fit into. Thus this curriculum offers insight to conflict resolution which may resolve interpersonal, intrapersonal issues that students may face. They will also discover grit, empathy, coping skills, and goal setting. 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be going into middle school next year and will be facing different situations moving into a new building. This program will prepare them by helping them find the spark within, further the discussion we started in the character education lessons about growth mindset to another level.

**How:** For the duration of 6-10 weeks, instructors will educate students in the classroom settings about the above topics and issues and help them to develop socially and emotionally.

2<sup>nd</sup> grade program: "Count on Me Kids" is about teaching and building self-esteem and overcoming peer pressures. Students learn about the difference between healthy habits and harmful behaviors.

4<sup>th</sup> grade program: "Conflict Resolution"/"Caution Without Fear" will educate students to evaluate consequences of their actions. Children learn peaceful techniques to overcome difficult situations on various levels: Interpersonal, intrapersonal, and within the community and beyond. The objective will also be to help children develop positive self-esteem, grit, empathy, coping skills, and goal setting.

6<sup>th</sup> grade program: "Peer Proof" helps students discover their "spark" in life, recognize difficult situations that may be faced and how to rise above them. The focus is growth mindset.

**Cost:** \$7,500

Camp Fire has pre-tests and post-tests to evaluate student growth. Teachers will have supplemental activities to reinforce the topics. There are take home activities for parents to reinforce.

As a character education initiative, we would to do a project called Rockin for Respect. We would like the students to paint rocks in their art classes. After the rocks are painted and dry, we will have the students place them in a "rock" bed along the perimeter of the school. The painted rocks will symbolize the student's unique creativity. The purpose of the project is to respect everyone's own individuality. We would like to promote self-worth. The goal is to keep this project going year after year, and eventually have the school's perimeter outlined in a brightly colored "rock" bed.

**DETAILS OF PROJECT (INCLUDE PROJECT SPECIFICS, TARGETED POPULATION, COSTS, ETC.**

All students in k-6 grade will participate in this project. The supplies we would need are 762 rocks, a wooden sign in front of the "rock" bed and Americana Patio Paint. 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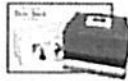

Our MD classes, two speech therapists, and Inclusion Pre-School have been using our limited amount of Adaptive Books in our classrooms and therapy rooms with great success. These Adaptive Books are actual published books with supplemental interactive visuals that accompany the story. They service General and Special Education students of varying abilities. These books lend to differentiation during Language Arts and Literacy Instruction.

## DETAILS OF PROJECT INCLUDE PROJECT SPECIFICS, TARGETED POPULATION, COSTS, ETC.

The product we wish to buy has adaptive pieces for 133 different books for all 12 months of seasons and themes. Each book set includes WH questions and a corresponding visual picture answer. The pieces have Velcro to allow student a multisensory approach to literacy.

The students that utilize these books have greatly varying abilities. Due to this, students access their curriculum in a one on one environment.
