

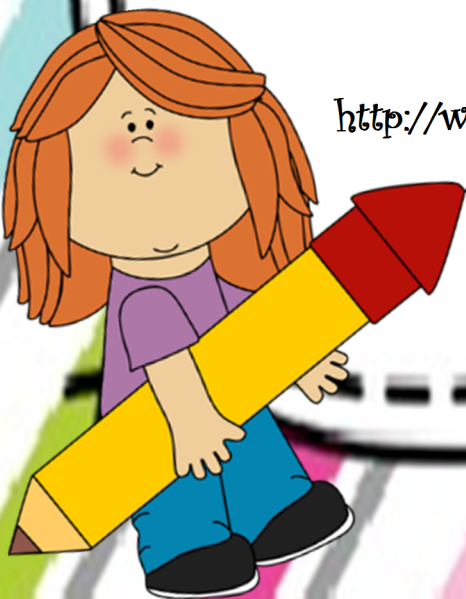

# 10 Journal Writing Prompts

## Suggested Use

Journal jars are a great way to spice up journal writing in the classroom. Kids often have difficulty choosing a topic to write about, and these prompts help get their creative juices flowing. I have personally used journal jars in my own classrooms and they are a hit!

Putting together a journal jar is fun and easy! Just take a used jar from around the house, preferably on the larger side, and decorate it using ribbon, felts, stickers and other fun crafts of your choice. Then, print out this journal prompt resource, cut out the topics, and throw them into the jar. You can have students pick topics daily, weekly, or however often you prefer. I find that picking 2 to 3 topics per writing session gives the kids more choice and increases interest and engagement.

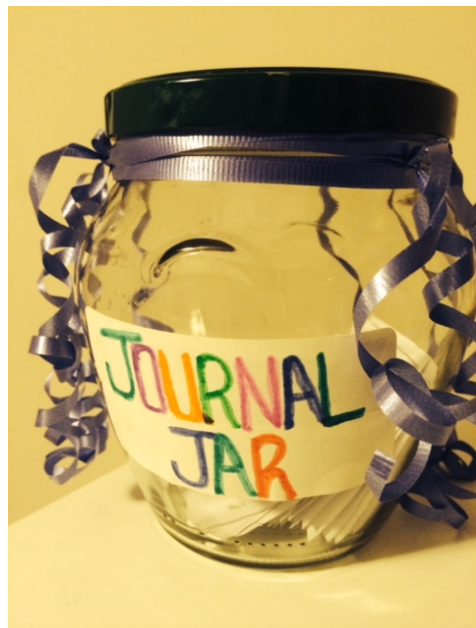
